YR 1 GROWING PLANTS

Did you eat a plant for breakfast?
Come see the range of plants we have growing here and think about why they grow where they do.

YR 2 VARIATION

Is it alive?
Are all plants the same?
Games and activities to look at how things can be grouped.

YR 2 PLANTS AND ANIMALS IN THE LOCAL ENVIRONMENT

What lives here?
Can you take the animals home and find their parents?

YR 3 SOILS

Investigate the amazing world beneath your feet. What is it?
How did it get there? And what lives in it?

What is a plant? What do they need?
Be a leaf and photosynthesise!

YR 4 HABITATS

Explore the woodland, meadow and pond and the animals living there. Why do animals choose different places to live?

YEAR 5 LIFE CYCLES

Come and consider the lives of plants. How do they grow and reproduce? What is a flower for? How can seeds grow legs?

YEAR 6 INTERDEPENDENCE AND ADAPTATION

Come and look at the huge range of animals we have in the nature garden. Why are they so different and how can we tell who is who?
